CHRISTIAN PHARMACISTS FELLOWSHIP INTERNATIONAL (CPFI)

Christian – I have been a Christian all my life. Growing up I was in the Methodist Youth Fellowship (MYF). When I was in college, I attended the Wesley Foundation at the University of South Carolina. After graduation I went to work for a drug store for about 5 years. Then, I went to work for Bristol-Myers Squibb (formerly E.R. Squibb & Sons). At the Shaw Air Force Base in Sumter, SC, the chief pharmacist handed me an envelope addressed to CPFI and said this was something he believed I might be interested in. The pharmacist and I had never mentioned Christian values in my visits with him. I applied to CPFI and Llewellyn and I attended the first annual meeting in Orlando, FL., July 14-17, 1988. This was my beginning of attending CPFI functions. To me, this just shows that our actions speak louder than our words.

Pharmacists – Pharmacists typically are very friendly people. For years, pharmacists were ranked as the most trusted of health professionals. They continue to consistently rank among the top professions for honesty and ethics. Students have their own network with student chapters, and we are very proud of them. Pharmacists and student pharmacists are very active on mission trips through Global Health Outreach (GHO). Usually, mission trips are one to two weeks in duration. Fellowship — When we look at 1 John 1:3, 4 we find it says, "We proclaim to you what we have seen and heard, so that you also may have fellowship with us. And our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son, Jesus Christ. We write this to make our joy complete." John writes about having fellowship with other believers. There are three principles behind true Christian fellowship. First, our fellowship is grounded in the testimony of God's Word. Without this underlying strength, togetherness is impossible. Second, it is mutual, depending on the unity of believers. Third, it is renewed daily through the Holy Spirit. True fellowship combines social and spiritual interaction, and it is made possible only through a living relationship with Christ. We have attended each annual meeting except one. Fellowship is one of the most significant functions of CPFI. Pharmacists from all over the U.S. come to our annual meetings for the CE that is offered plus the fellowship of our members.
