### **Code of Conduct**

CPFI has approved a Code of Conduct that applies to all leaders, including Student Chapters. We live in a fallen world, but I am amazed at how quickly our country seems to be moving into immorality. In his book "A Call For Courage" Michael Anthony says "when speaking about the time just before his return, the Lord said, "Because of the increase of wickedness, the love of most will grow cold" (Matt. 24:12). Jesus calls his followers to stand out, not blend in. A real Christ-follower must live and behave as a minority in a majority world." Without a willingness to make careful choices, guidelines to follow, and a sense of accountability to a biblical standard, our lives may look no different from those around us. Michael Anthony says "Bible-reading Christians who truly love God and want his best can see the truth contained in 1 Corinthians 10:23: "I have the right to do anything," you say but not everything is beneficial. "I have the right to do anything"—but not everything is constructive."

We believe that Christians should love their neighbors but should not follow a non-Christian lifestyle. Although there may be some disagreement as to all elements in a Christian lifestyle, many elements are endorsed unanimously by classic Christianity because they grow out of our statement of faith. We believe that these are the elements that are included in our Code of Conduct. Your Board has all signed this statement and we are now rolling it out for other national leaders and CPFI Student Chapter leaders to sign.

Should you have any concerns with our Code of Conduct, please let us know. Although we are not expecting members to sign that they agree with this Code, we do suggest that they may still want to use this Code to guide their own lifestyle.
