

Impact of Non-Adherence:

About 1/3 of All Rx's are Never Filled by Patients

About 50% of All Rx's are Not Continued by Patients

About 50% of All Rx's are Not Continued by Patients

Especially after 6 months of Therapy

Hypertension = 51% Non-Adherence

Statins = Up to 50% in 1st Year

Non-Adherence → ~50% of Treatment Failures


Cost per Year: \$390 Billion!




Provider Factors Influencing Patient Non-Adherence:

- Communication skills
- Knowledge of health literacy issues
- Lack of empathy
- Lack of positive reinforcement
- Number of comorbid conditions
- Number of comorbid conditions
- Number of medications needed per day
- Types or components of medication
- Amount of prescribed medications or duration of prescription










































Repeat this musical phrase again. Step 2: Now play the note on second string at the 3rd fret (C). Then play the note on the third string at the 5th fret (G). Then play the note on the third string at the 5th fret (G). Then play the note on the third string at the 5th fret (G). Then play the note on the third string at the 2nd fret (E). Then play the note on the second string at the 5th fret (D). Then play the note on the third string at the 5th fret (D). Then play the note on the third string at the 7th fret (A). Then play the note on the third string at the 7th fret (A). Then play the note on the third string at the 7th fret (D). Go back to step 2 and just play it once. End by playing step 1 once but add a last note by playing the second string at the 5th fret. Repeat if you'd like. Good luckl
