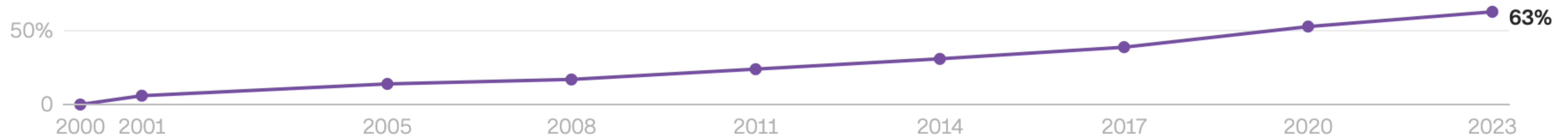

Medication abortion is more common than ever in the US

There were about 642,700 medication abortions in the United States in 2023, nearly two-thirds of all abortions nationwide.

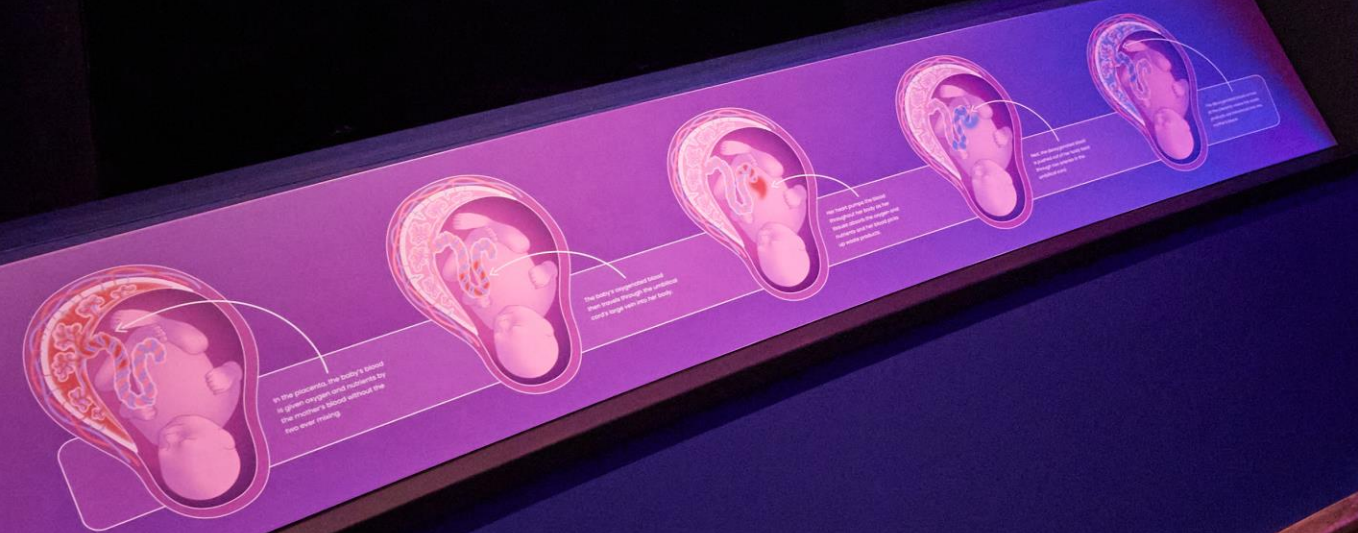

LIFELINE

All cells receive their genetic "blueprints" from parents at the moment of fertilization. The blueprint is passed on through the process of meiosis, which produces sperm and egg cells. These cells combine to form a zygote, which then develops into a fetus.

THE GIFT OF HUMAN LIFE

WHEN DOES HUMAN LIFE BEGIN?

This question lies at the heart of some highly contentious issues in our world. From a medical standpoint, there is only one logical answer: life begins at fertilization, when the chromosomes from the sperm and the egg combine, forming a genetically unique individual.

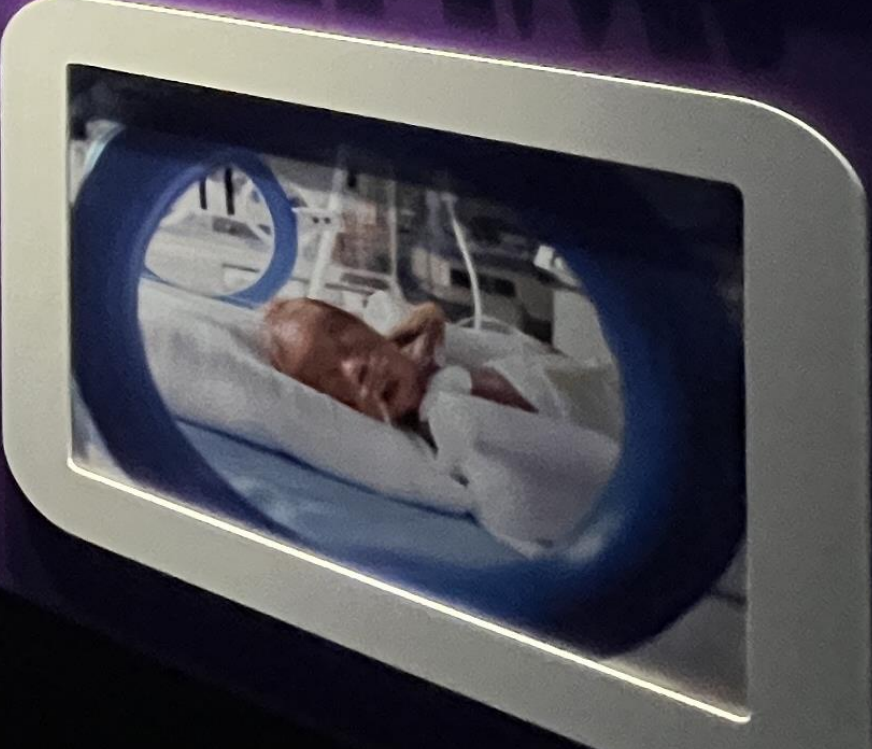
Our medical knowledge of this process has caused the debate to shift from "When does life begin?" to "When does personhood begin?" or "When do the unborn feel pain?" But these questions avoid the real issue. Whether one refers to the unborn as an embryo, fetus, or baby, we learn from God's Word that a human being made in the image of God is growing and developing within the mother from the moment of fertilization.

MICRO PREMIES

Babies born prior to full term are called preemies, due to their premature delivery. Those born prior to 24 weeks (24 weeks gestational age) are called micro preemies. Thanks to medical advances, micro preemies now enjoy much higher survival rates. They may spend much from early delivery is decreasing. The number of micro preemies to survive were born around 26 weeks (22 weeks gestational age) and weighed less than a pound. For example, Lyla (pictured below) was under 20 weeks at birth (17 weeks, 4 days gestational age).

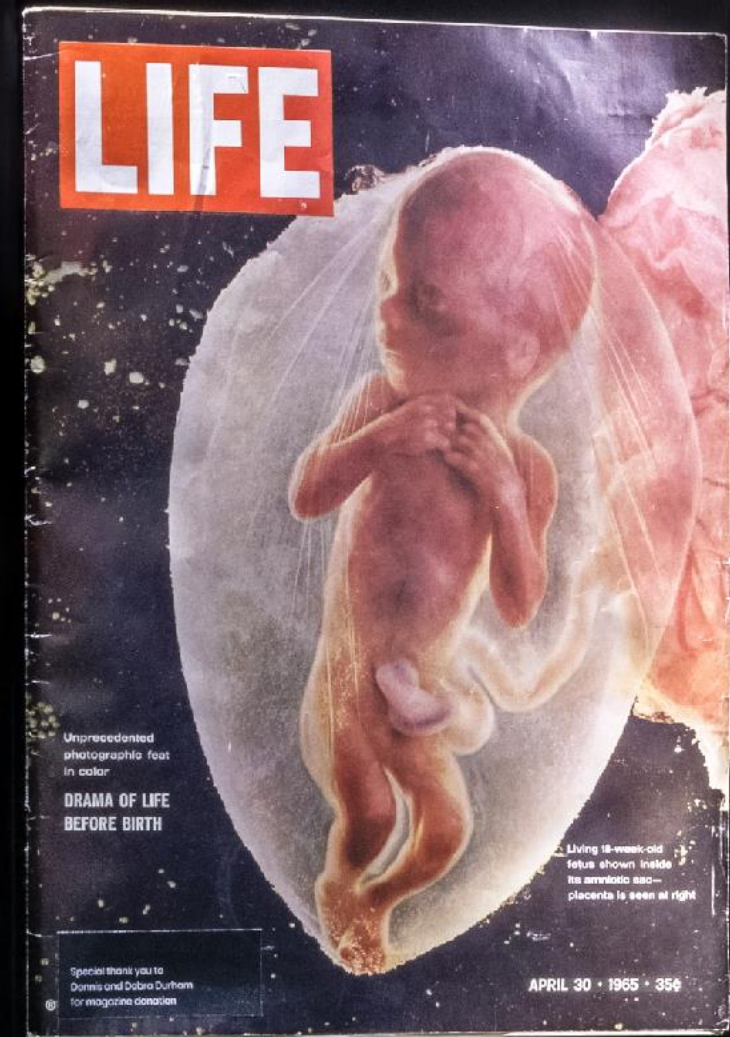

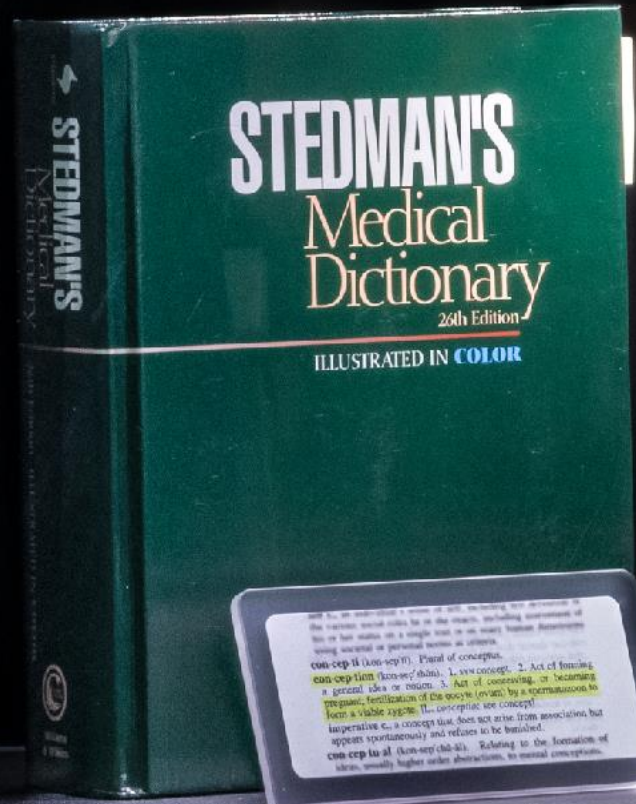


POP CULTURE CHANGES

Cultural arguments for abortion often appeal to a supposed common sense understanding of a woman's right to choose. This argument implies that recognizing life in the womb is an outdated view. Indeed, two magazine covers, only 35 years apart, present a dramatic shift in thinking at the turn of the century.

LIFE MAGAZINE
Life magazine from 1955 depicts a clearly recognizable baby at 16 weeks gestation and uses the word "living" in describing the image.

TIME MAGAZINE
Time magazine from 2000 presents the abortion pill at the world's fingertips, using the word "finally" to describe something that would end the life of that 16-week-old child pictured in *Life* Magazine.

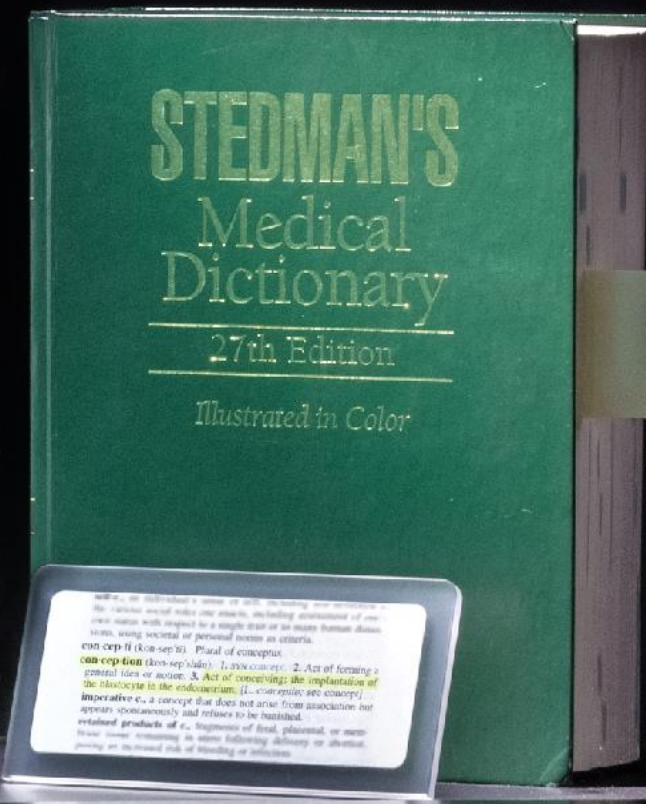


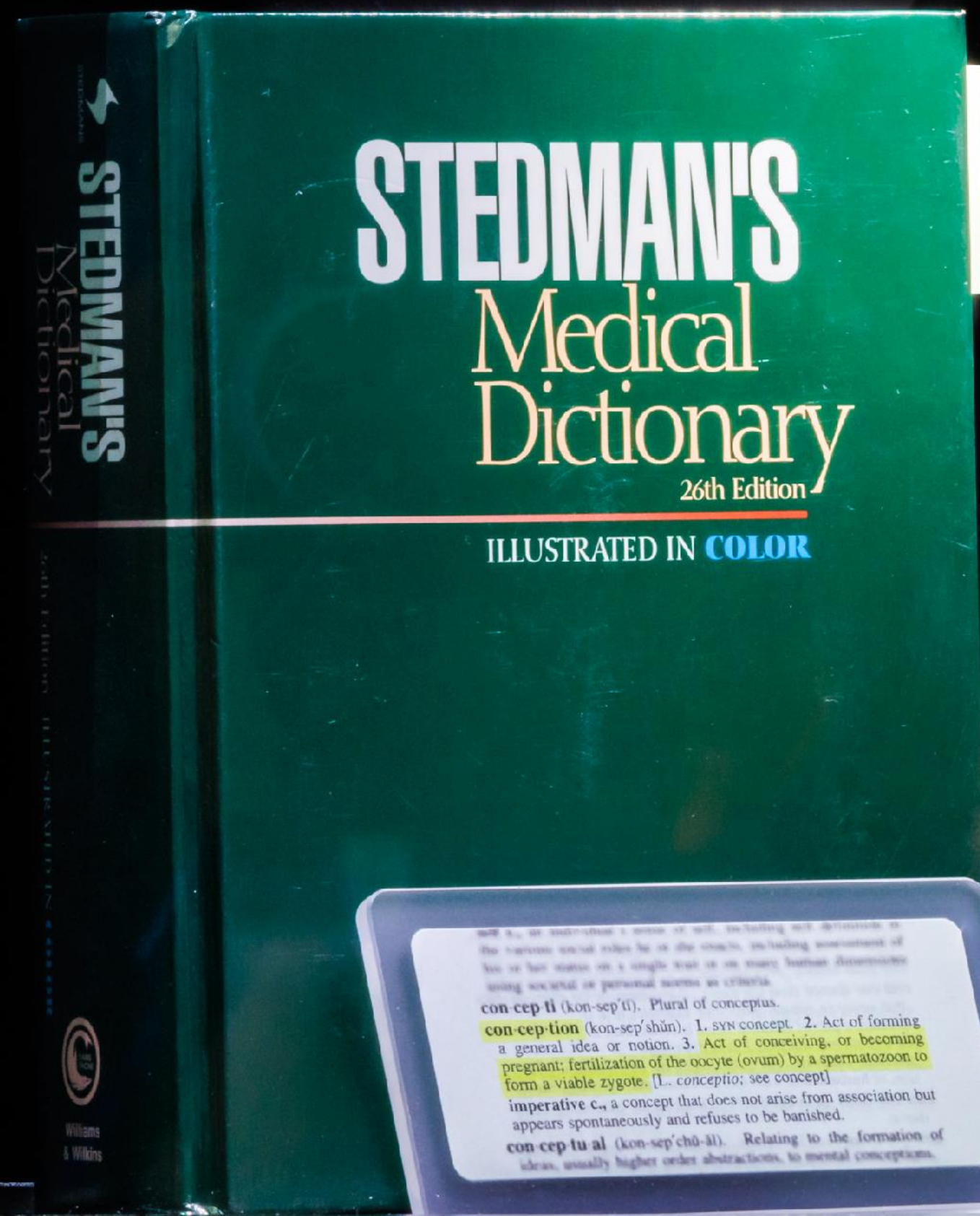
"SCIENCE" CAVES TO CULTURAL PRESSURE

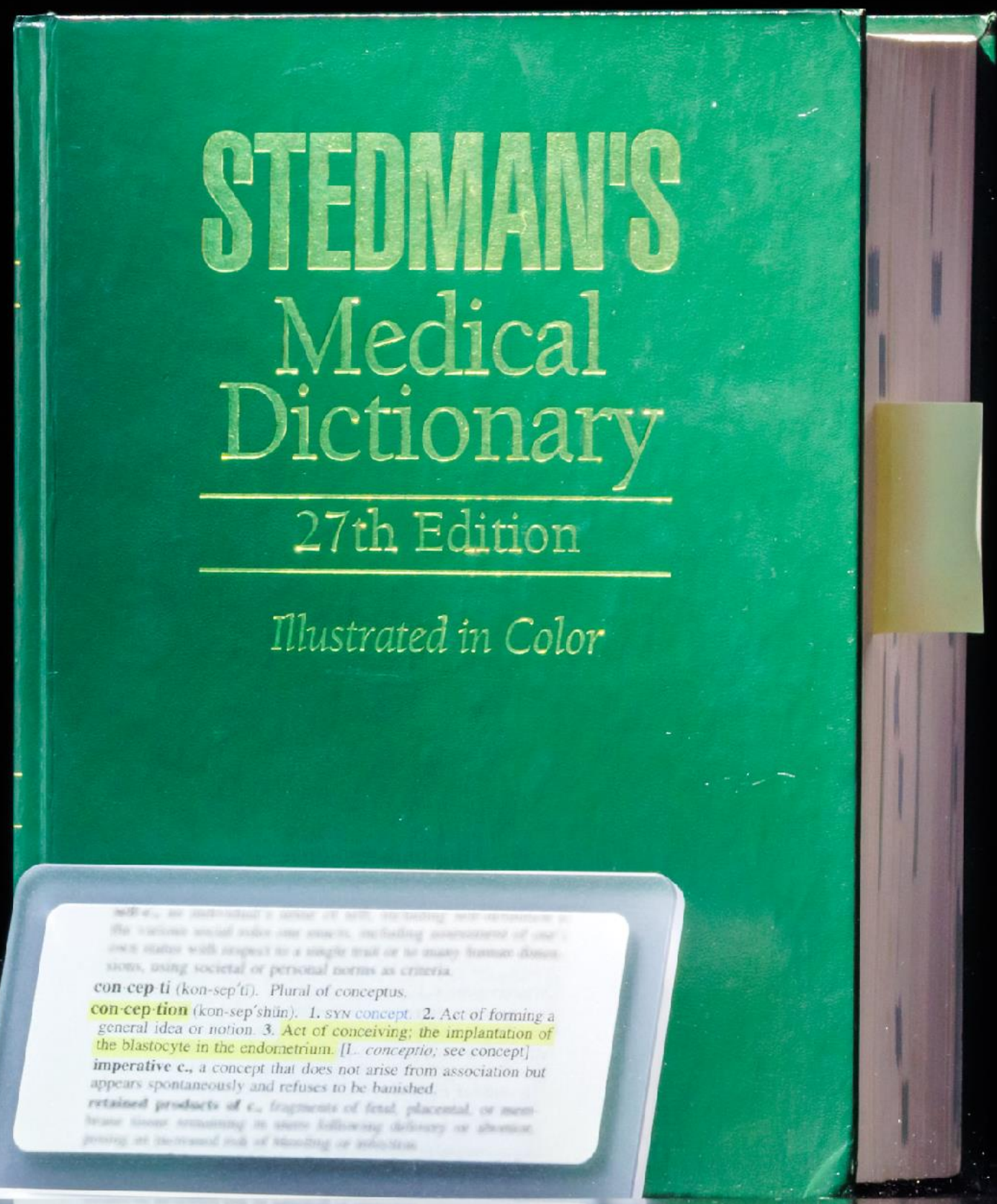

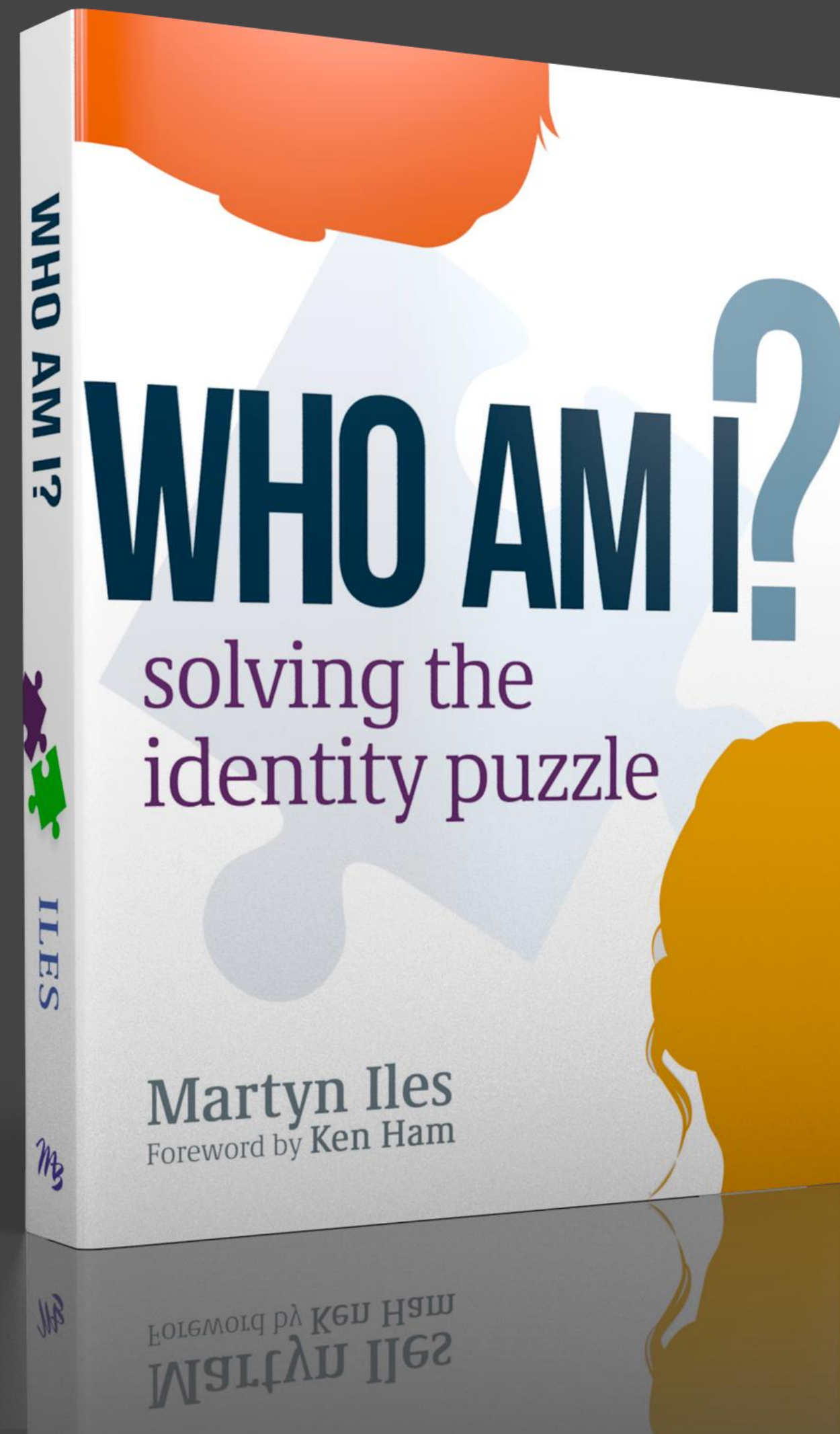
