## Medicine, Missions, and Miracles: How God is Using Pharmacists at Samaritan's Purse

In 1977 Franklin Graham, a business student at Appalachian State University, traveled to Papua New Guinea with Bob Pierce, the founder of Samaritan's Purse, and Dr. Richard Furman, a thoracic surgeon practicing in Boone, North Carolina. On that inaugural trip, Franklin Graham saw *first hand* the profound impact medicine had on international ministry. He there professed that "medicine was a magnet for the Gospel".



# Medicine, Missions, and Miracles: How God is Using Pharmacists at Samaritan's Purse

In 1978 Franklin Graham became the CEO of Samaritan's Purse, and moved its International Headquarters from California to Boone, NC. Samaritan's Purse quickly evolved into a multisector disaster relief organization, and medicine eventually became one of its primary sectors of focus. Today, Samaritan's Purse has diversified its medical sector to include Emergency Field Hospital deployment and disaster response, World Medical Mission (a network of over 50 mission hospitals world wide), Surgical subspecialty teams, Children's Heart Project, and Community Medical Outreach.

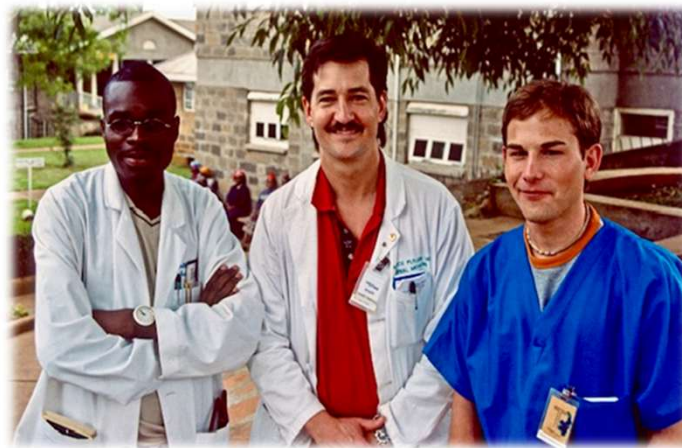
- Today, World Medical Mission (WMM) Partners with over 50 mission hospitals worldwide.
- WMM supports the mission hospital through sending volunteer medical personnel (physicians, nurses, therapists, and pharmacists).
- WMM sends 40 foot medical containers to partner hospitals with state of the art durable and renewable medical equipment.
- WMM has established a Post-Residency Program that sends physicians (and pharmacists) on a 2 year “fellowship” to serve long-term in partner hospitals.

### Disaster Assistance Response Team

- A specially-trained team deploys with the Emergency Field Hospital to perform setup, with the goal to have the hospital operational within 24 hours of arriving on-site. In Jamaica, the team was assisted by members of the Jamaican Defense Force.

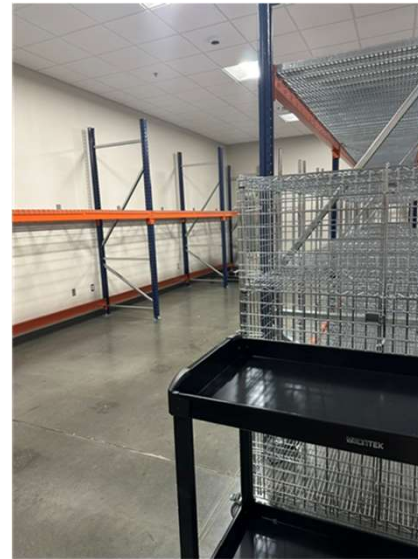

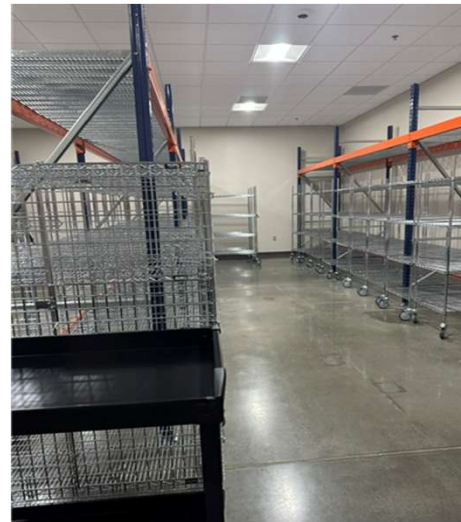
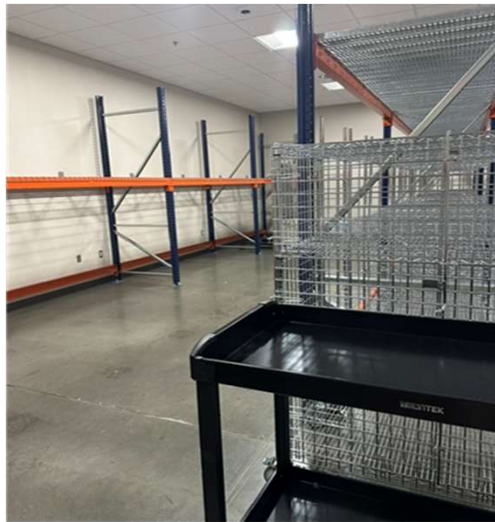

## *Medicine, Missions, and Miracles: How God is Using Pharmacists at Samaritan's Purse*

- FTZ: a designated area (within our Wilkesboro Medical Supply Warehouse) where SP can import, store, and export pharmaceutical supplies directly to international destinations.
- Can export without being subject to US custom duties.
- The pharmaceuticals must still comply with US FDA regulations.
- Advantage: We have ready access to our Emergency Field Hospital Formulary in order to deploy promptly on mission critical deployments.
- Significant cost advantage.

## ***Medicine, Missions, and Miracles: How God is Using Pharmacists at Samaritan's Purse***

- Minimum two years' experience as a Pharmacist in a clinical setting is required
- *Clinical pharmacy experience within the last five years is required (these are the same standard clinical requirements listed for other professional healthcare providers [i.e., physicians and nurses] and are not expected to change).*
- *Inpatient hospital experience required (working to change “required” to “preferred”).*
- *Completion of accredited training as a Pharmacist with current active licensure in sending jurisdiction (not expected to change).*

## ***Minimum Requirements for Pharmacy DART Roster (Time Commitment For Training)***

- DART Training – one week, 8 hours per day, small stipend included
- MedLogs/Pharmacy Training – one week, 8 hours per day, small stipend included

### Disaster Assistance Response Team

- Equipped with multiple operating theatres, more than 250 surgeries were performed in the EFH deployed to Myanmar, where local medical facilities were severely damaged in the earthquake.

- Community Medical Outreach (**CMO**) provides free primary medical, dental, and vision care in Jesus' Name. This ministry of Samaritan's Purse works together with local churches to provide quality healthcare to underserved communities in the United States.
- Our intent is to provide holistic care, addressing both the physical and spiritual needs of each patient.

### Community Medical Outreach

- Our Ophthalmology Care includes eye care tests for color vision, depth perception, astigmatism, and corrective lenses. Patients pick out their unique frames while their lenses are crafted on site. Upon completion, each pair of glasses is fitted to the patient. A full range of medical care is also offered complete with some prescriptions.
