The Impression of Novel Christian Music Playlists on **CPFI Members at Wingate University School of Pharmacy**

Objective:

To determine the impression of monthly Christian music playlists on CPFI members at Wingate University School of Pharmacy (WUSOP) by analyzing survey feedback.

Methods:

- A 10-question survey created on Google Forms was sent to a CPFI email list, including faculty and students (P1-P4)
- Survey was posted on Instagram and Facebook
- 10-day timeframe to complete the survey
- Playlists were created monthly on Spotify and Apple Music platforms from September-April by CPFI members
- Playlists were shared in the CPFI weekly email and on Facebook

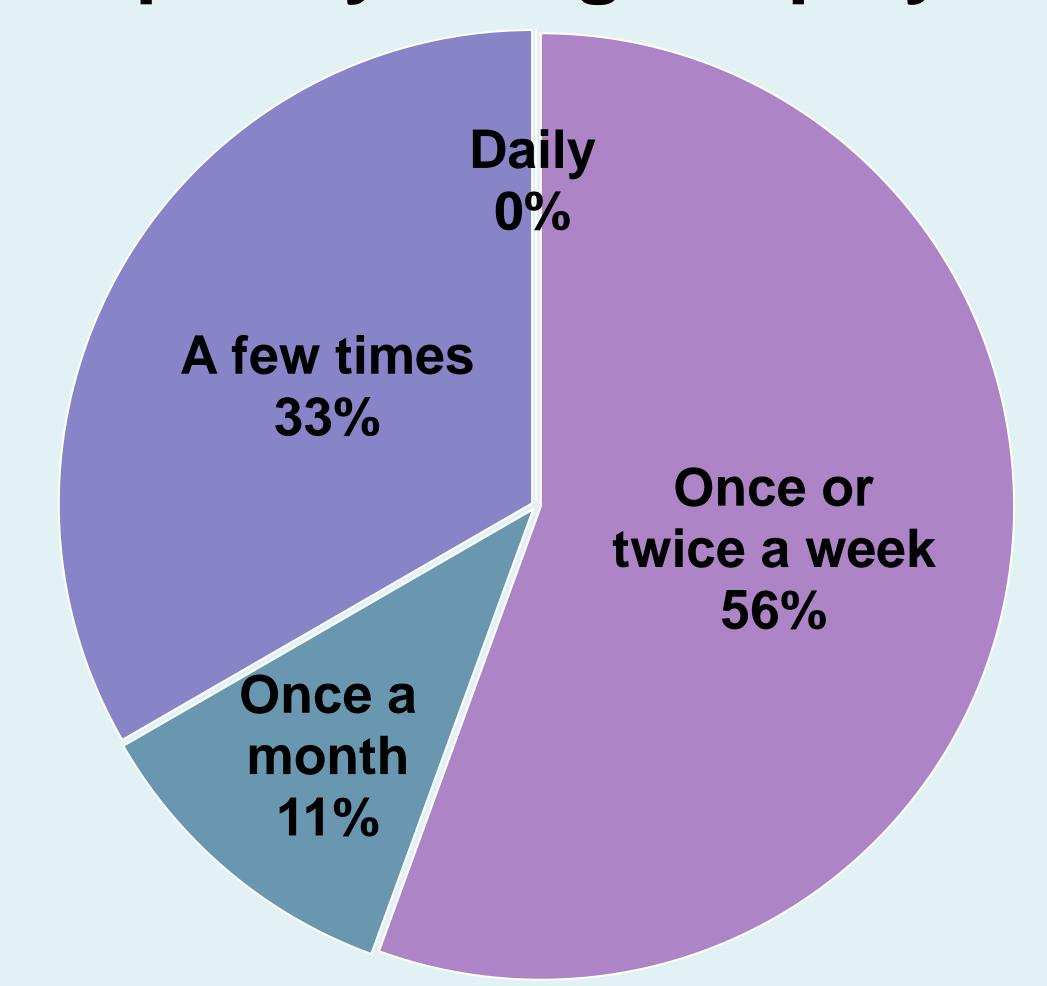
Conclusion:

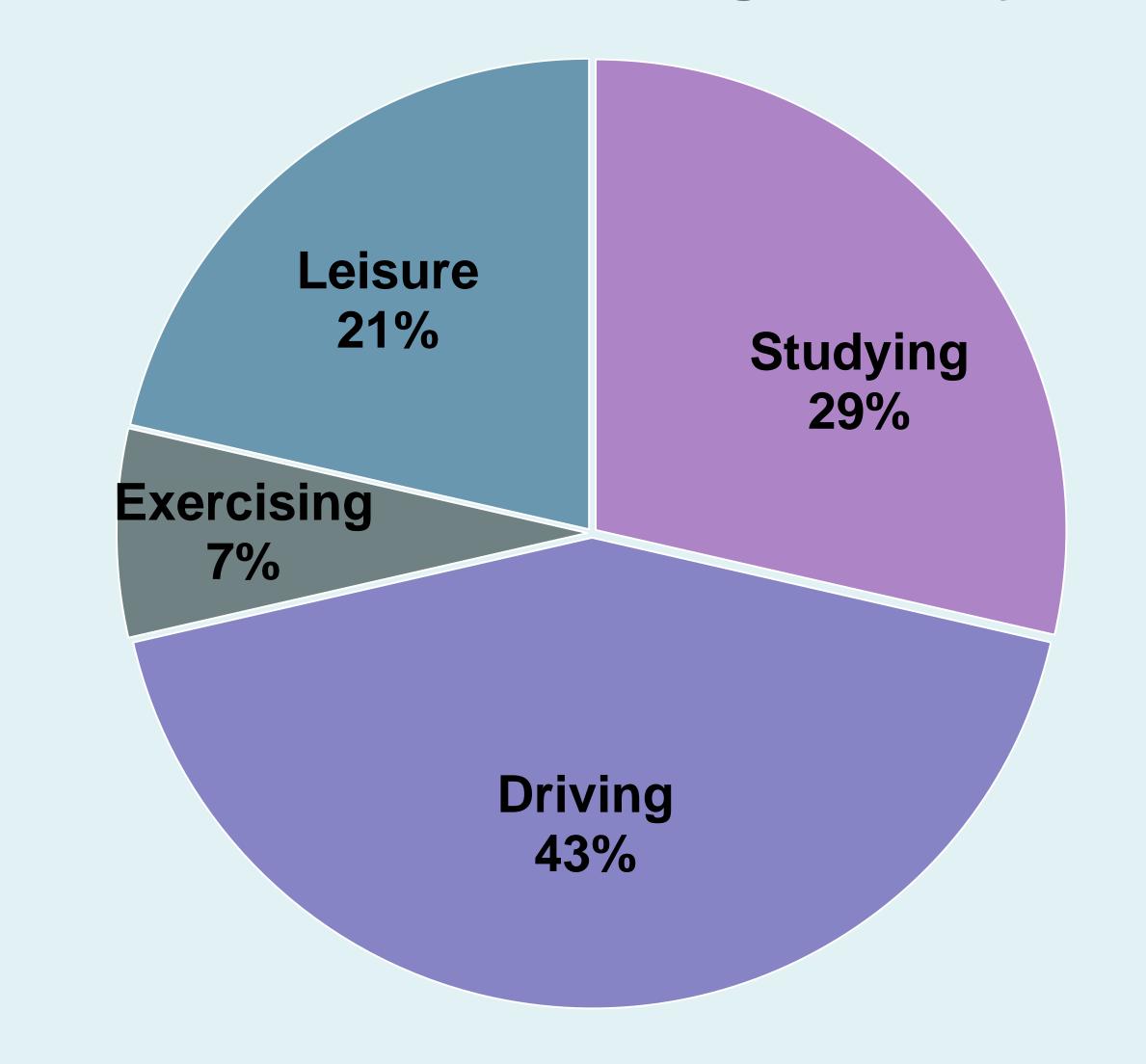

WUSOP CPFI members listen to and feel at peace when listening to Christian monthly playlists

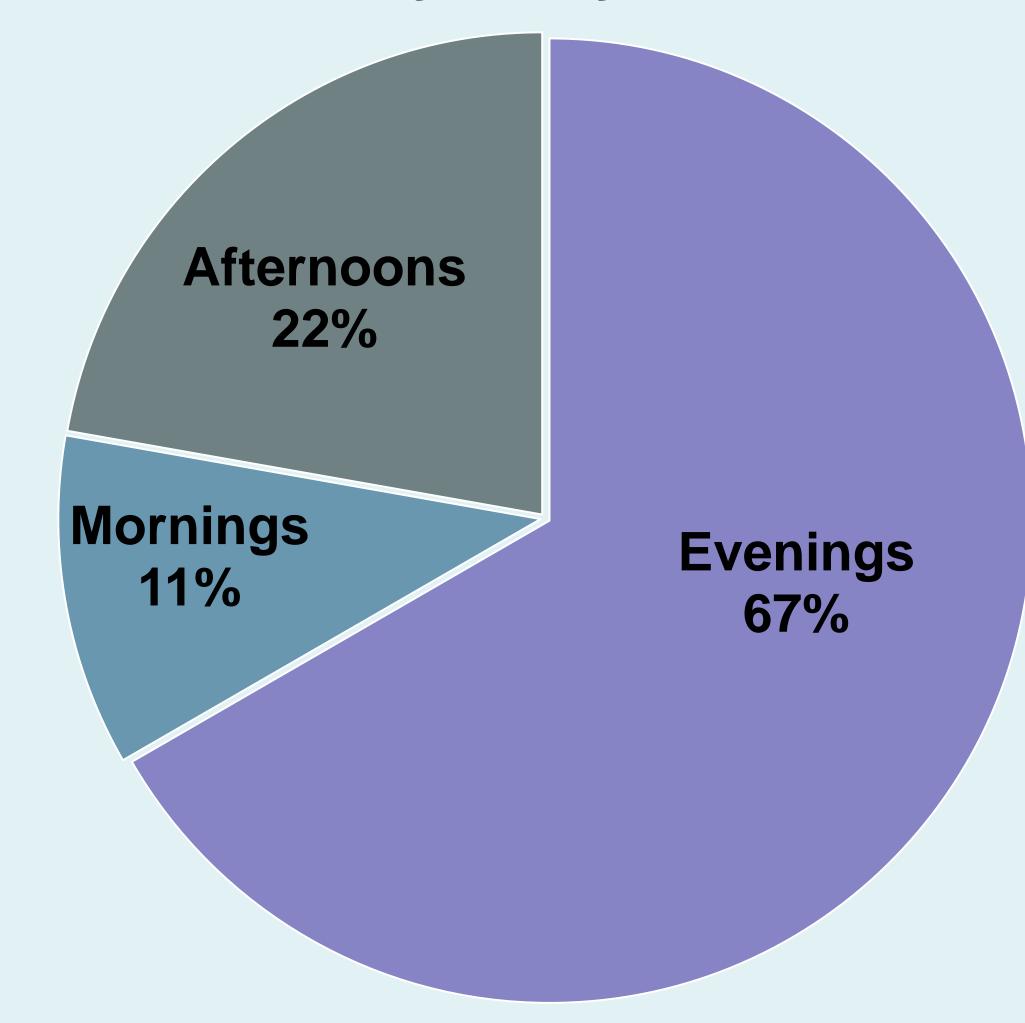
Results: Frequency using the playlists



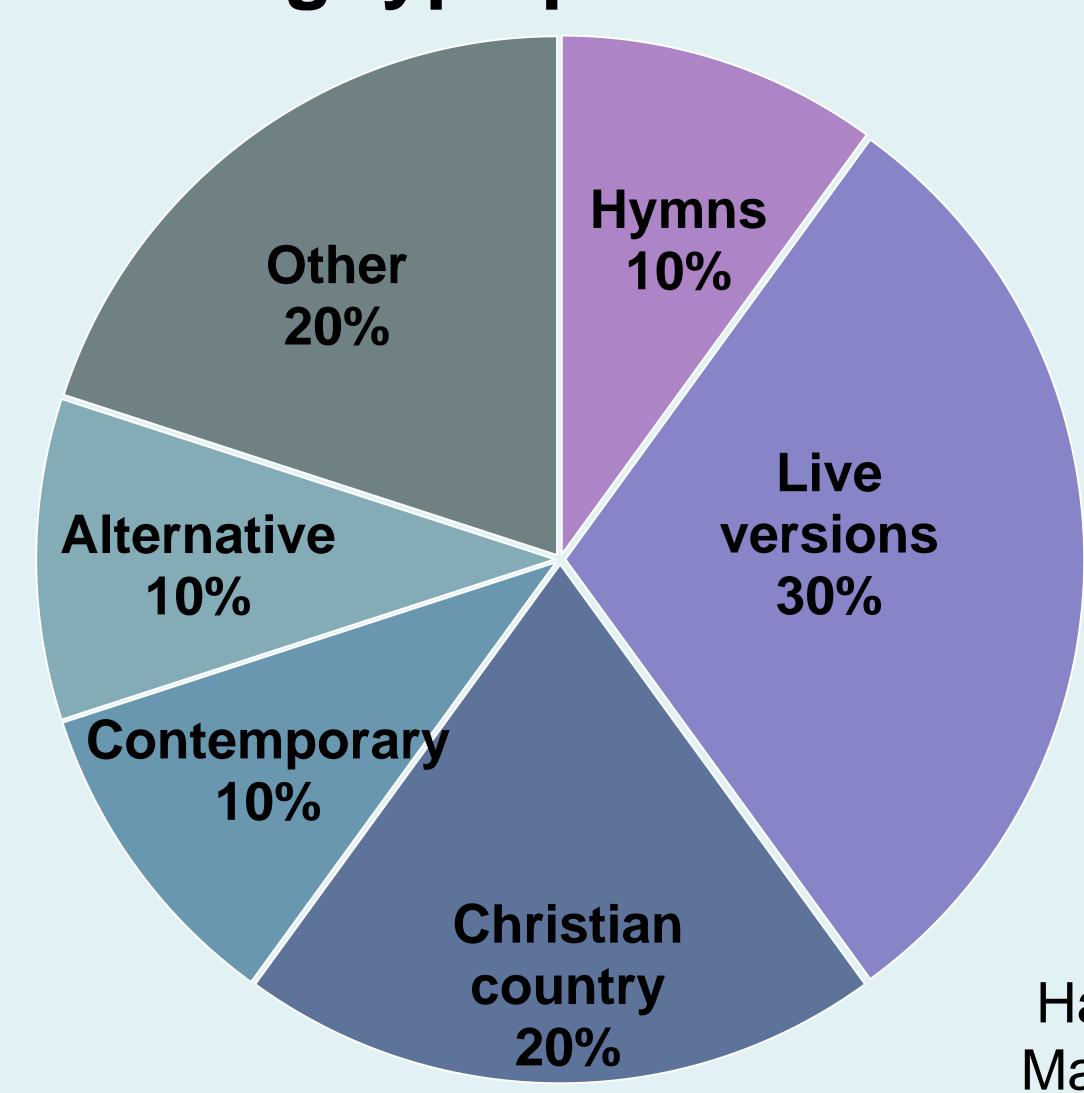
Tasks while listening to playlists
