Background

- “Como familia” is the motto of La Diferencia Hospice meaning “like family” which is how they take care of their patients
- Gonzaba Medical Group has been an integral part of the South San Antonio community for the past 60 years. Helping such a pillar in the community and working with the elderly was an effort done by the entire FSOP student chapter.

Methods

- Fleece, cardstock and more fleece were purchased from Walmart.
- Two blanket-making social events were advertised on student platforms.
- 31 student helped support the making of this project
- A \$100 monetary donation was made with the remaining funds.

25 blankets were made and dropped off, along with a monetary donation towards the hospice center.
