



## **NSC CPFI Mentorship Program**

**Purpose:** This program's objective is to provide an opportunity for student pharmacists to connect with and receive guidance from pharmacists that work/have worked in their field of interest. Mentors will build a professional relationship with their student(s) and serve as a point of contact for any career-related questions.

### **Once you've been paired with a mentor:**

- When you email your mentor also schedule an initial meeting (virtual or physical) and include multiple dates and times to work with your mentor's availability.
  - This initial meeting will allow you to learn more about your mentor and ask them any questions regarding their pharmacy experience.
- After this meeting, if you decide to set up additional meetings, that is up to you and your mentor. If not, you can continue talking and asking any pharmacy related questions via email.
