

Christian Pharmacists Fellowship International Student Chapter Advisory Committee (SCAC) Report

November 9, 2021

Dear CPFI Board of Directors:

We pray this message finds you well in the midst of the unprecedented times we have been navigating through the past two years. In brief, our report includes follow up on old business, updates in the leadership of our committee and the National Student Council (NSC), ongoing activities, and our future goals for the SCAC.

Old Business: Student Scholarship

BACKGROUND: Pakou headed the Student Scholarship Task Force (members: Jeff Copeland, Jeff Bates, Dan Spadaro, and Susie Kim) in 2019-2020 following the 2021 Board Meeting. At the time, Dan Spadaro stepped down from office as Chairperson of the Student Scholarship Committee. The goal of the task force was to update the purpose of the Student Scholarship and submit a proposal to be reviewed by the Board

- The proposal included a revision of the standing Student Scholarship Policy and Guidelines, and a new Application Form and Expense Form
- All documents were submitted to administration and the Board for review in Spring 2020 to be discussed at the June 2020 annual meeting
- No further update has been received from the board on the status of the Student Scholarship

Follow-up questions / Points to be addressed:

- Will there be further discussion on the Student Scholarship for a final decision to be made on the proposal and voted on?
- Will the Student Scholarship be dissolved altogether and funds be reallocated for another purpose?

Completed Tasks

Together we have accomplished the following tasks since the summer

- Reviewed the 2021 CPFI Hands and Feet Grant proposals
 - $\circ~$ We have funds to award up to (5) grants in the amount of \$500 each for eligible chapters
 - We received a total of 7 submissions this year of which none of the chapters met the minimum eligibility criteria to be considered for review
 - We have extended the deadline to Saturday, November 13th to allow a one-week grace period for the chapters to complete any necessary tasks to become eligible
 - Winners will be selected and be reported to Nena by Sunday, November 14th
 - $\circ~$ Final grant determinations will be sent out to faculty advisors on Monday, November $15^{\rm th}$
 - Our target date for issuing grant checks to awardees at latest, if possible, is by Friday, November 26th

Future Goals

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Our goals for the student ministry moving forward:

- Streamline the role of the SCAC and fill in any gap areas
 - Compile a list of all standing documents utilized by student chapters
 - Clarify if there is an archive where records are kept and create one if it does not exist: e.g. all forms, student chapter bylaws that have been submitted, etc.
