• Events and Activity

- NSC Connect
 - We had 3 monthly Zoom meetings with local chapters from January to April (Prayer night, bible study/devotionals, Q+A, Election/National
 - Suggested goal for next year of start in October with ~6 total meetings
- Newsletter
 - Our publicist, Jenny Widener, created one newsletter earlier this semester highlighting different events from local CPFI chapters,
