CPFI Educational Affairs Committee Report May 9, 2024

The Educational Affairs Committee has assembled another very promising conference for May/June of 2024. Discussions focused on programming feedback from the three most recent years as well as consideration for audience recommended topics and presenters. A great blend of regular as well as new speakers was included. Adding a few new speakers each year has proven to be a helpful approach in attracting additional CPFI members who have become more and more involved.

The CPFI annual conference is completely planned for May 30-June 2nd in Flat Rock, NC. The regular program contains up to 12.25 hours of continuing education credit. One of our regular speakers, Dr. Emily Laswell, will again offer an elective Saline Process option on Saturday afternoon. At the time this report was written, 46 participants had voluntarily chosen to participate in this event. Participants in this year's conference could earn a maximum of 13.25 hours of CPE – a truly terrific value!

In addition to general CPE sessions, topics and speakers were intentionally chosen with the intent of granting Law and Pain CPE credits. Unfortunately, a CE session was not available in the Medication Safety space this year. This variety of CPE credits is valued a great deal by many conference attendees due to various licensing bodies having specific requirements for these areas. As in years past, Campbell University is managing the CPE credit for CPFI and has been very responsive to all needs.

Per request of the CPFI Board of Directors, (at least) two CE sessions will have a live stream option in addition to the live presentation. This approach will allow CPFI members who could not attend inperson to join remotely. Unfortunately, this approach will not be of the highest video quality, but it will certainly be functional, allowing participants to join in for a few of the sessions.

Our team is grateful for the opportunity to serve Christ and our members through the Educational Affairs Committee, and we are very excited that we can offer an exceptional, high-quality conference again this year.
