The National Student Retreat starts Wednesday, May 28<sup>th</sup>. The CPFI Board of Directors meeting will convene, and the Annual Conference starts on Thursday, May 29<sup>th</sup>. There will be continuing education as well as prayer and praise times. An awards presentation will be held Saturday, May 31<sup>st</sup>. The Conference will conclude with a worship service Sunday morning, June 1<sup>st</sup>.
