Pharmacist Spotlight

Susan Smith, BS,
PharmD, BCPS



Dr. Susan Smith is an Associate Professor of Pharmacy and Director of IPE for Wingate University School of Pharmacy in Wingate, NC. Her experience prior to academia includes 20 years of practice as an inpatient Internal Medicine Clinical Pharmacist Specialist. In May of 2024, Dr. Smith accepted a 3-year term as a CPFI Board member. She states that God led her to CPFI shortly after joining Wingate University School of Pharmacy in 2016.

One of the most special connections Dr. Smith had with CPFI at Wingate University was In 2019 when she had to face a hematopoietic stem cell transplant. During this difficult time, she states that members of the CPFI chapter offered to donate bone marrow and their hair. Although not needed, the gesture amazed Dr. Smith on how powerful God can work in people's lives. During her recovery, she states that many members brought her gift baskets and cards that included the same Bible verse which has become her favorite verse and is listed below. Prior to becoming a faculty member at Wingate University School of Pharmacy, Dr. Smith had never heard of CPFI but wished she had. She got to experience first hand all of the ways members of CPFI spread good to their communities. Since then she has participated in many events including volunteering at a local pregnancy center to educate mothers on how to treat newborn illnesses with over-the-counter regimens. Since becoming a CPFI Board member in 2024, Dr. Smith states that she is eager to see where God leads her in the future.

Salvation Army



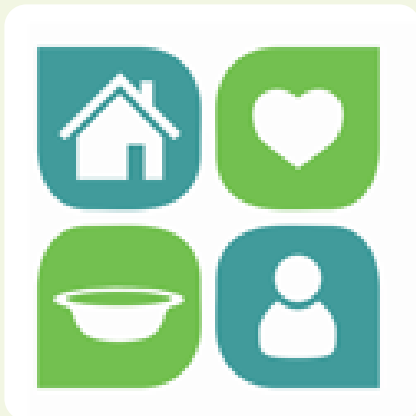
The Salvation Army offers all volunteers the opportunity to assist at shelters and organize food drives.
