

# *Dr. Warren E. Weaver Service Award*

***“For Following our Lord’s Example of Service to Others”***

The Dr. Warren E. Weaver Award was established in 1990 “to identify the person who most exemplifies the Lord’s example in service to others through CPFI.” This Award is the highest honor given by CPFI. Warren E. Weaver, considered the founder of CPFI, lived by the verses from Philippians 2:1-4:

*“If you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any fellowship with the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and purpose. Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves. Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others.”*

This year’s recipient of the Dr. Warren E. Weaver Service Award is Dr. Wagdy Wahba. He recently retired after 13 years of service to the Lloyd L. Gregory School of Pharmacy (GSOP), Palm Beach Atlantic University, West Palm Beach, Florida.

Dr. Wagdy W. Wahba exhibits these characteristics by daily serving others. He is admired by his peers and has been a great encourager and mentor to his students. Using Dr. Wahba’s own words from one of his short term medical mission team lectures at GSOP: “While serving in the field remember that you are called to serve (Ephesian 2:10), that you are Christ’s ambassador (2 Corinthians 5:20), be sensitive to God’s voice when He calls you to something, (e.g., saying a word of encouragement to someone, assuring somebody of God’s love, a gentle touch on the shoulder or the back, connecting with the locals), be flexible, be gracious to all, and serve with a joyful attitude.” “When you return home, give God the glory and the credit for what He has done (Matthew 5:16)...Always remember...it is God’s work, we are just workers in His field, His servants and ambassadors, and it is a privilege to be in His plan of reaching out to others (1 Corinthians 3; Ephesians 2:10)”. Wagdy Wahba lives what he teaches.
