Being a Blessing to Others

Three Practical Ways

1. We can bless others with our **WORDS**. Encouraging words build up others. We should be courteous and gentle. We should show mercy, forgiving and affirming one another. *“Be wise in the way you act toward outsiders; make the most of every opportunity. Let your conversation be always full of grace, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how to answer everyone”*. Colossians 4: 5-6 (NIV1984) We have to be careful not to slander gossip or speak negatively. Such actions do not produce blessings; *“.....To slander no one, to be peaceable, and to show true humility towards all men”*. Titus 3: 2
2. We can bless others with our **PRAYERS**. Peter was blessed by the believers’ prayers. *“So Peter was kept in prison, but the church was earnestly praying to God for him. Suddenly an angel of the Lord appeared and a light shone in the cell. He struck Peter on the side and woke him up. “Quick get up!” he said, and the chains fell off Peter’s wrists”*. Acts 12: 5, 7 Jesus stated in Matthew 5: 44: *“But I tell you: Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you”*. Loving and interceding on their behalf in prayer will bless others and bring glory to God.
3. We can bless others with our **ACTIONS**. The Bible is full of instructions to put our faith in action. James 2: 17 tells us that *“faith without action is dead”*. The Apostle John encourages us to be a blessing to others by our actions *“Dear children, let us not love with words or tongue but with actions and in truth”*. 1 John 3: 18 Because if we wait for perfect conditions to act, we will not get anything done.

Starting today:

- Let us, in a practical way, be a blessing to others. We can do that by our kind words, by praying for them and by our actions. We cannot do that on our own but *“because God has poured out His love into our hearts by the Holy Spirit, whom He has given us”*. Romans 5: 5
