| Christian Pharmacists Fellowship International was incorporated 36 years ago in 1984 by our founder Dr. Warren E. Weaver, with eight charter members. (For more in-depth details of CPFI's history written by Dr. Weaver, please see "The History of Christian Pharmacists Fellowship International" in <u>Christianity & Pharmacy</u> 1996, Vol 1 pp 5-9 at CPFI.org.) CPFI's activities grew from prayer breakfasts at the Virginia Pharmacists Association annual meetings to providing unique pharmacist continuing education (CE) by hosting our own annual meetings in 1988. Dr. Weaver wrote at the time, "For the first time in pharmacy, CE sessions were offered which integrated explicit and implicit Christian concerns and principals with professional subjects." This, along with <i>The Faith Script</i> newsletter and the initiation of CPFI's journal, <i>Christianity & Pharmacy</i> , expanded membership to 1000 pharmacists by 1995. As students attended or heard about CPFI, they began to ask about student chapters.
